- A three-week Induction Programme for Students
- For fulfilment of human aspirations and attainment of full human potential
- To help the students appreciate the essential complementarity between 'VALUES' and 'SKILLS'
 - ✓ Ensure sustained happiness and prosperity
- A journey based on natural acceptance
 - ✓ Filled with self-inquiry, self-exploration, and self-discovery

Sample and the analyses

- Subsample: 500 observations (students), selected randomly
- *Observation: Pre and Post UHV-I responses*
- Histogram: Data levels are in percentage



- Students had a greater understanding affinity for self, family, and the institution
- Students exhibited a higher concern for the social engagement, natural environment, and nation
- Among students, no significant change was observed for the importance of skills for job and money


Importance in My Life (2/3)

- A significant and positive shift observed (5% to 10%)
- Higher clarity would motivate them to actively participate in the nation building





Post UHV-I

Skills for Job & Money: A positive shift observed (drop by 2-3%)

Students exhibited a higher willingness to participate at societal, natural, and national level: A rise by approx. 10%


Post UHV-I, students felt

- Need of a higher contribution in motivating them to participate at society and nature development to make the nation strong




- A significant and positive shift observed for all the variables



Purpose of Education and Human Aspirations

Notation	Description
V19	The role of education is to develop full human personality
V20	The basic purpose of getting educated is to get a good job.
V21	Money is the most important thing in human life
V22	The needs of a human being are unlimited
V23	People living in a society cannot have a common goal and there will always be conflicts in society
V24	There is struggle for survival in the nature, and only the fittest can survive
V25	The problems that you see around you are mostly due to lack of skills
V26	The problems that you see around you are mostly due to lack of relationship, concern for each other
V27	The problems that you see around you are mostly due to lack of resources

- Students still lack clarity on the basic purpose of education and importance of money. (UHV-II needed)
- Students attributed reasons for the problems to lack of skills, lack of relationship, and lack of recourses.
- As they are young and the UHV were recently introduced, UHV-II would help in developing clarity on these topics


- Students had a greater understanding of the topics listed (purpose of education, competition, etc.)
- The shift was positive and significant for all the topics


Purpose of Education and Peer Pressure

- Purpose of education: A positive and significant shift (more than 10%)
- Similarly, a positive and significant shifts were observed for competition and excellence
- Students had a better clarity and understanding of the peer pressure.








- A positive and significant shifts were observed all the topics (10-15%)
- A better clarity and understanding of Happiness, Trust, Respect, Gratitude, Love, and Irritation (anger) would lead to excellence.








- A positive and significant shifts were observed all the topics (approx. 15%)
- Clarity on the self and role in family, society, and nature would positively contribute to building better tomorrow and strong nation.
