

Post FDP Guidelines for Participants

(Version 2.0 15th November 2019)

Minimum faculty preparation required to be a UHV-I facilitator:

- One 3-day FDP-SI (UHV), if required for orientation
- One 7/8-day UHV FDP
- Regular self-study after attending the UHV FDP
- Weekly meeting with other UHV faculty in the college/university/city/state/region

The 3-day FDP-SI on UHV is intended as the orientational input.

The 8-day FDP-SI on UHV is intended as the main input with comprehensive content, process and practice sessions.

Please note that this FDP-SI on UHV is not intended to prepare you as the coordinator of the SIP. However, it can be of immense value to SIP Coordinators as well, in terms of providing the underlying vision for human education for the development of the full potential of human personality and a humane society, which is just and equitable.

So, when you return to your institution, please:

1. Brief your principal / director about the FDP-SI you attended.
 - a. Give an overview of what you learnt and salient aspects of the workshop
 - b. Share a copy of your self-evaluation form
 - c. Share a copy of 'A Guide to Student Induction Program'. The SIP is to be coordinated by Dean, Student Affairs or Dean, Academic Affairs or some other suitable authority at your institution. In addition to the UHV-I module, the SIP has many components like Creative Arts, Physical Activity, Visits, Lectures by experts, etc. This guide outlines all these activities in some detail; and it would be helpful for all involved in the SIP
 - d. If you have attended the 3-day FDP-SI
 - i. And if you are interested to prepare yourself as a UHV-I facilitator, share your intention and seek support for attending the 7/8-day FDP-SI
 - ii. And if you are interested to help in coordinating the SIP, share your commitment and seek support for it
 - iii. And if you are not interested in any role in UHV-I or SIP, share your reasons. Also report these reasons to AICTE through an email to the convener NCC-IP and Local Program Coordinator
 - e. If you have attended the 7/8-day FDP-SI, and you are interested to facilitate the UHV-I module of the SIP, share your commitment and seek support for it.
2. Share your experience with your colleagues

If you are committed to understanding and facilitating UHV-I, then you must make effort for:

1. Preparing yourself with self-study and self-exploration. There is quite some reading material
2. Developing a local / institute team of UHV-I facilitators. One of the ways found effective is a weekly meeting of all the interested faculty members who attended an FDP-SI. You may also include interested faculty members who attended an FDP-SI from nearby institutions. The key is a definite place, a definite time and one or two committed faculty members who show up for every meeting no matter what, rain or shine! Are you one of them?
3. Conducting the UHV-I module during the SIP
4. Taking initiative in the post-SIP follow up activities, like weekly meeting with students in small groups etc.
